“Opening a **La Honda** office has been a goal for Puente for more than five years, said Executive Director Kerry Lobel...

...Puente's role as a service provider in Pescadero has grown tremendously in recent years. Among its services, the group organizes weekly aerobics classes, food handouts, drug counseling and job opportunities and training...

...Since 2007, Puente has offered mental health counseling and monthly food distribution in La Honda, which have increased in demand recently. She said her organization would be studying La Honda to find what services are lacking...

...the organization also showcased a new La Honda version of the "Pescadero Grown!" farmers market. Building off the success of the two-month-old Pescadero street market, Puente organizers believed the same formula could be expanded to La Honda. Like the Pescadero market, the new La Honda bazaar features primarily South Coast growers and producers who want to sell directly to consumers. Eight vendors attended the debut market last week...The La Honda farmers market is scheduled to run from 4:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m. every Tuesday until November.”

**Mary Bordi and the Seaside Schoolhouse**

"Mary Bordi sits at a contemporary table in sunlight filtering through the windows of what was a one-room seaside schoolhouse, just south of the San Gregorio Store. Outside, it's nondescript: weathered white walls, three green-framed windows, wooden steps...

...This circa-1871 building, the San Gregorio School - before that known as Seaside School - was the primary subject of a talk given by Bordi to a score of history aficionados of the **La Honda Historical Society** here on Thursday evening. Her talk ranged over the times that one-room schools like Seaside "were their own school districts" like Tunis School, the last functioning one-room school in the area, which closed when the Cabrillo Unified School District opened in the 1960s. Later, like so many old buildings, it burned to the ground; frequently, sparks caused by fires started in the buildings by chilly transients were the cause, Bordi said...

...The history is something she knows well, as the descendant of several generations that called this corner of the Coastside home. Her grandmother and mother were schoolchildren here. So, she said, was current Half Moon Bay Mayor Naomi Patridge. Her mother's second-grade teacher, Mildred Bracesco, took her first teaching job here and held it until the school closed down in the 1950s, Bordi said.

Her parents bought the actual schoolhouse when the site was "up for competitive bid" in the mid-1960s through San Mateo County, Bordi said. They paid \$2,500 for it; a sum her grandmother "thought ridiculous. But that was the 1960s."

Bordi recalled her mother's stories of seeing the lights of ships dropping contraband off on the coast during Prohibition. In the 1970s, her nephew farmed here. "He was like the sixth generation," Bordi marveled..."

"A mountain lion was spotted Friday night near state Highway 84 in southern San Mateo County, emergency officials said.

The big cat was seen near the highway and Sequoia Drive in **La Honda** at about 9:40 p.m.

This mountain lion sighting follows two others earlier this week on Monday and Wednesday nights in Portola Valley.

Residents are advised to keep an eye on small children and avoid hiking or jogging at dawn, dusk or night when mountain lions are most active..."

## Two Youths who walked away from La Honda detention Camp Arrested

"Police brought a short-lived escape to an end Wednesday afternoon when they arrested two teens who had walked away from a La Honda detention camp for kids in trouble with the law.



The teens, who were not named because they are 16 and 17 years old, were picked up on Lawler Ranch Road in Woodside around 1 p.m., police said. Officers had been chasing them since early Wednesday morning when

residents first reported seeing the boys, who had run away from Camp Glenwood the previous night.

They were arrested without any trouble, and a deputy took them to juvenile hall, said San Mateo County sheriff's Lt. Ray Lunny.

"...The problem of juveniles walking away from the camp appears to have been bigger in previous years. The facility clocked at least 12 runaways in 2008, including one who committed a murder while AWOL. Adrian Sedano was convicted in July 2010 of killing 23-year-old Ramon Buenrostro in Redwood City."

## Peninsula Converges in Half Moon Bay for Coastal Cleanup Day

"On Saturday morning, volunteers from all over the Peninsula converged along the Half Moon Bay Coastside to collect trash and recyclables for the 27th Annual California Coastal Cleanup Day...Organized by the San Mateo Countywide Water Pollution Prevention Program and the California Coastal Commission, the event was held at ten locations from Montara to San Gregorio...Cleanup crews met at locations which included Montara State Beach, Mirada Surf West in El Granada and Francis State Beach, Poplar State Beach, Purisima Creek Redwoods Open Space Preserve and Pilarcitos Creek in Half Moon Bay. Along the South Coast, volunteers met at Pescadero State Beach, Gazos State Beach and San Gregorio State Beach...The main focus of the day was cigarette butts...Last year more than 4,200 San Mateo County volunteers picked up over 42,000 pounds of trash and recyclables."

## Ferns: Strategic Planning Part II

Thirteen years ago when we moved to **La Honda**, one of the first things we did was to build a stairway up the front of the house. In order to do this, we dug up a huge fern and planted it in a new bed. I can still vividly remember my astonishment when I looked at it after a couple of days and saw that the entire plant had rotated its fronds to orient itself to receive the sun.

Last month I wrote about the life cycle of the gorgeous bull kelp and how it has adapted to life in a reliable but ever-changing world. The ferns are wonderful examples of another ancient group of plants which are elegantly suited to their environment.

This winter we found masses of small verdant, almost succulent leaves in one of our beds of daffodils and narcissus. Maybe you have seen plants like these and wondered what they were, as they sure don't look like ferns.



These are one stage in the life of the common leather fern, borne from the fusion of the brown spores which we see on the back sides of ferns.



This winter some of them will grow into the more recognizable fern form.

## Art alive and well in South Coast Schools

"The Art in Action program, a mainstay in schools closer to Half Moon Bay, is "alive and well," said La Honda-Pescadero Unified School District Superintendent Amy Wooliever. She added that it brings something vital to developing young minds... There's also a parcel-tax-funded district music program. It covers general and choral music sessions once or twice a week, with annual winter and spring performances.



This year's spring program will be a musical, Wooliever said. **La Honda** Elementary School teachers also wrote and obtained two grants from the South Coast Artists' Alliance in Pescadero and from the Philanthropic Ventures Foundation on the Peninsula to bring in art teacher Danny Goldberg for several sessions in the first half of this year. Students were introduced to cartooning and art around the creatures and native arts of the world.

"It was a wonderful program," said **La Honda** Elementary School Principal Kristen Lindstrom. She added that, with some grant money left over, she brought Goldberg back for eight more weeks, starting in late September.

"It's a challenge for parents to do extracurricular activities" like art activities over the hill or in Half Moon Bay, she said. "It's so helpful to have artists in **La Honda** after school..."

"A 120-year-old farmhouse and barn both burned to the ground as a result of an early Monday morning fire off Cloverdale Road in Pescadero...the unoccupied house and barn were completely engulfed in flames, fire officials say. The homeowner had scaffolding and other equipment lying around the house. He was in the process of restoring the historic house, according to a neighbor...Fire officials say they were fortunate that the fire occurred on a foggy wet day. If conditions were hot and dry, Cosgrave said they could have faced a much larger fire."

### New ADA-compliant parking space at Cuesta playground

(excerpt from <http://groups.yahoo.com/group/LaHonda/message/27577>) (A discussion on the **La Honda** message board centered around the ADA compliant parking now being installed at the Cuesta Playground) "In the process of researching (for the Guild newsletter) a paragraph explaining the new ADA-compliant parking space at the playground, I took a close look at the DMV form for obtaining a "disabled person placard or plates." [see the link and excerpt on message board]. To obtain a placard, a medical professional must confirm that a California resident has a relevant disability or medical condition. Several medical conditions are listed that might not be obvious to a casual viewer, such as lung disease. I've known people who need the blue-and-white placards because they use wheelchairs, and others who need the placards because of neurological problems, such as multiple sclerosis and a condition that causes sudden dizziness, that were not obvious. Handicapped access is a very good thing. Please have patience and compassion." posted by Sally Bachman

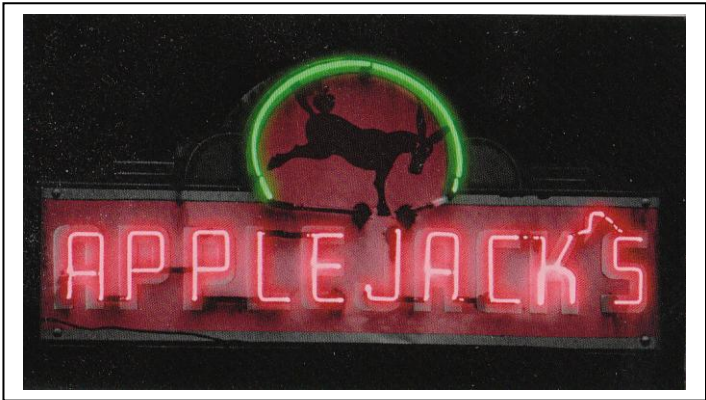

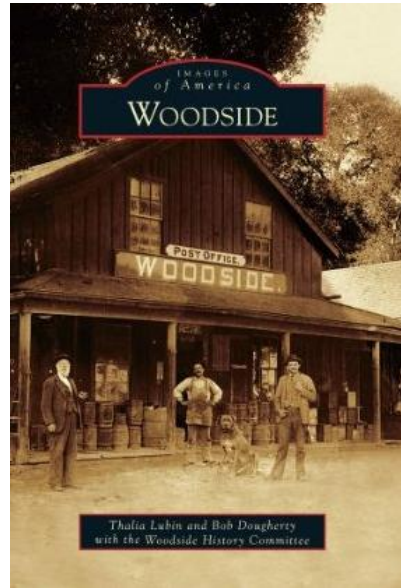
